

# Academic writing: Writing Introductions

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
### The one question you'll never be asked....

"Write down everything you know about this topic."

Exam questions ask you to answer a question or solve a problem.

Quality not quantity!

### Model to generate Critical Thinking



### What shape is your introduction?

One way of thinking about the introduction is as the top of a funnel. The beginning is very wide, where the general topic is given, and it gradually becomes narrower as youintroduce the specific focus. At the bottom there is a hole, which is the start of the body. The body directs the discussion of the topic and (hopefully) reaches an answer or solution to the original question or title.

### Your introduction could include...

• What is the question about?

• Why is the question important?


• How are you going to answer it?

### The introduction may...

- begin with a general statement about why the topic is important in your area of study
- set out the main idea of the essay
- sum up in one or two statements your overall answer to the question
- specify the scope of your essay
- outline the structure of your essay
- define important terms
- explain the methodology to be used and why it's being used
- include a quote to grab the reader's attention
